

SUMMARY OF GISBORNE MARKET RULES

The GREAT Association Inc. is a registered Not For Profit organisation, and manages the Gisborne Olde Time Market for the benefit of the community. Stallholders and visitors must obey all legal directions that are issued by our volunteers, for the safety and comfort of all.

Traffic Management is now in place for the benefit of all; visitors and stallholders must obey all traffic signs.

All accidents and incidents must be reported to the Market Manager at the Market Office next to the Mechanics Institute building.

Stallholders and visitors may not bring dogs into the market, for the safety and health of all.

The market will be cancelled on days rated as Catastrophic in the Central District.

STALLHOLDER RULES

- Stallholders must deliver goods & equipment to their site before 7.45am. All vehicles must be removed from the market site before 8.00am. Stallholders must be ready to trade at 9am. Stallholders must remain on their site until 2pm then pack down before bringing vehicles into the market after 2.10pm.
- Stallholders must confirm bookings and pay fees one month in advance. Advance notice is required if fees are to be carried forward, at the discretion of the management. Stallholders may lose their permanent status if they do not attend 8 markets in a calendar year or are absent for 2 markets without notice.
- Stallholders can apply using the official Application Form, providing photos of their products and submitting copies of their current public liability insurance. Alternately they can participate in the GREAT group insurance. Food Vendors must have their own public liability insurance and must be registered with Streetrader. Only items approved by market management may be sold. Raffle ticket sales must be approved by market management.
- Sites are 3m X 3m and marquees must be weighted with 15kg weights on every leg. No tent pegs may be used anywhere in the market. Displays & advertising must be confined to the site.
- All stallholders' rubbish must be taken away by the stallholder. Bins are provided for market visitors only. Stallholders are expected to attend in all weathers.
- All equipment must conform to OH&S and compliance standards, and certificates must be displayed where required. Stallholders must comply with rules relating to safety, food storage & handling. Appliances must comply with gas & electrical requirements. Electrical leads must be tested & tagged. Catering vehicles must display a compliance plate and carry fire-fighting equipment as required. Front & rear of marquees must be fully open when gas burners are in use.
- Stallholders must not smoke within 5 metres of any stall in the market area.
- The market is generally unable to provide on-site parking for stallholders and it is the responsibility of stallholders to park legally elsewhere.
